Dining: You can expect to eat 3 times a day, around the city and each meal should cost about \$15.00 (tax and tip included). That means \$45.00 per day and approximately \$225.00 for eating during the entire trip. Feel free to adjust as you see fit.

How will we get around while in New York?

Travel: We as a group will be using the Subway! Nothing says New York, like traveling by these world-famous trains. A MTA weekly pass costs \$30.00 and will cover travel within the city for the entire trip. (Additional money for the occasional taxi might also be a good idea.)

What's the total cost and how will we receive payment?

Cost: Using the prices above the trip comes to a total of \$869.00

$[\$300(\text{hotel}) + \$314(\text{flight}) + \$225(\text{food}) + \$30(\text{MTA weekly pass})] = \869.00^*

**Adjust this price to include any paid attractions listed that you'd want to attend; for quick math if planning to purchase tickets to all 4 attractions listed with prices, the total would become: \$978.00*

Payment Planning: To make the trip as affordable as possible, we suggest paying in five (5) installments over the next 16 weeks. We're planning on purchasing the plane tickets as soon as possible so the down payment is paying for that ticket. Below is a list of dates/ payments we suggest.
